Hello,

As we work toward Oregon's clean energy future, we're strengthening the energy grid to make it smarter, more efficient and more reliable for you. Among our many improvement projects, we're planning to upgrade our Harrison substation, located at 1925 SE 8th Ave. We'll begin updates to the substation and nearby underground power lines in the coming weeks. We anticipate completing the first phase of this project in early 2020.

As a first step, we want to let you know about some preliminary work to verify the location of underground utilities. This step will help keep you and our crews safe during this project.

You may notice colored paint lines appearing on streets and sidewalks in your area. These colored lines identify the location of underground lines for telecommunications, water, sewer and other utility services. The marks will guide our designers, crews and contractors as we partner with the city and county to plan for the least invasive path for the new power lines. This helps prevent construction delays and lowers the likelihood of accidental disruption of any services when drilling.

What is core drilling?

In mid-September, our crews will begin core drilling, which involves cutting into the sidewalks so we can verify both the location and the depth of the different pipes and cables. As soon as we're done checking a hole, we'll patch it closed until we start our underground line work later this fall. More information about our substation upgrades and construction schedule will be mailed to you soon.
