# To improve your service, we need to trim and remove some trees


We're strengthening the energy grid to make it smarter, more efficient and more reliable for you. As part of this work, we'll upgrade power lines in the West Union area later this year. In preparation for the new lines, we need to trim and remove some trees along the power line rights of way in your neighborhood.

## Tree maintenance schedule

- April through June 2019
- 7 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Monday through Friday

*This schedule may change based on the needs of the project. While not anticipated, weekend and night hours may be required at times.*

## What can you expect during this work?

You'll see crews from our contractor, Asplundh Tree Expert, working along the areas highlighted on the map above. They will be trimming branches and, in some cases, removing trees that have grown too large for the spots where they are planted within the power line rights of way.

**We're taking steps to ensure your safety. Here's how you can help:**

- **Watch for temporary one-lane and full-street closures that may be needed.** Allow extra time for commuting through these areas.
- **Follow any detours and signs** placed to keep drivers, pedestrians and workers safe.
- **Please avoid all work areas and equipment,** and make sure children know to never touch the equipment.

Once the tree work is complete, we'll install the new power lines that will boost reliability and reduce the risk of outages for your neighborhood.
