What is the contract length?	Clean Wind contract is month to month.
How much will Clean Wind cost?	\$3.00 per MWh (1,000 kWh).
Will my rates change over time?	Clean Wind prices are based on current Oregon Public Utility Commission approved tariffs. Pricing is subject to change. All price changes require approval from the OPUC. Customers will be notified of any price change in advance.
What are the enrollment options?	There is a minimum purchase of \$3.00 per MWh/month. In order to participate in Commercial & Industrial Clean Wind, a customer must have a qualifying rate schedule (schedule: 38, 49, 75, 83, 85, 89 or 90) or elect to aggregate usage through Oregon Department of Energy if site usage is greater than 1 aMW. In order to enroll, customers must contact PGE to obtain and sign a purchase agreement.
What other fees might I be charged?	You must also pay all applicable federal, state or local taxes.
How will I be billed?	You can elect to either be invoiced separately from your PGE Bill monthly or annually; or your Clean Wind charge will be listed as a separate line item on your monthly PGE electricity bill. In either case, this charge is in addition to your regular electricity bill.
Can I cancel my participation?	You can cancel at any time with no fee. There is no minimum contract length.
If I want to terminate this agreement/contract, what is the early termination fee?	You can cancel at any time with no fee. There is no minimum contract length.
What is a REC product?	Clean Wind C & I is a Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) product and does not contain electricity. A REC is created when a megawatt hour of renewable energy is produced and delivered to the grid. RECs increase demand and drive development of more renewable energy sources. All RECs purchased on behalf of Clean Wind C & I customers conform to Green-e [®] Energy National Standards and are registered with the Western Renewable Energy Generation Information System (WREGIS). Our customers' Clean Wind C & I purchases support Western region-supplied new renewable energy.
